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## REMINDERS

- Please remember to send in your **child's passport** and **European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)** by Monday 15<sup>th</sup> May. (You may bring them to the evening meeting if you wish.)
- Please send in **2 separate envelopes** – named and labelled – by Monday 15<sup>th</sup> May:
  1. Your child's Euros (**max 35€** -£30 worth- in SMALL denominations)
  2. English money (**max £10**) for the return journey for their evening meal.  
(You may also bring these to the evening meeting if you wish.)In addition, they may also have **up to £5** with them for the outward journey if they wish to make a purchase on the ferry ...or for use at the Tuck Shop at the Château (English money & Euros accepted).  
(We will be taking the early afternoon Dover to Calais crossing with the P & O Ferry Company.)
- Please send in any medication which your child may need by Monday 15<sup>th</sup> May. This can be given to Mrs.Crowther who will pass it on to Mrs.Hitchen. Items include asthma inhalers, hay fever remedies, paracetamol, eczema cream, travel sickness medicine, etc. Please ensure that they are in date.
- Does the school have your **up-to-date mobile phone contact details** to receive texts via our school message service? We will keep you updated over the weekend ☺. (Please note – the mobile phone contact which is logged in the school system will be the one by which you receive any messages. The contact numbers collected by Mrs.Hitchen are for emergency purposes.)
- **NO MOBILE PHONES OR DIGITAL CAMERAS ON THE TRIP.** (Disposable cameras only allowed.)
- Small games, personal stereos, books, etc. are allowed for the journey but **DO NOT** bring anything that could be lost or damaged. Children who bring any electronic equipment must take full responsibility for these items at all times, as they will **NOT** be covered by our insurance.
- A **packed breakfast and lunch** will be needed for the journey to France (the coach is due to arrive at 4.15 am for a 4.40am set off!) plus bottled –still - drinks. Please have the food in disposable wrappers. The coach company (Sharpes of Nottingham) has a strict **NO CHEWING GUM** policy.
- Don't forget your **named sleeping bag** and your **own pillowcase** (and a **pillow**, if you wish!)
- Please remind your child to wear comfortable clothes for the journey and to put a change of clothes in their rucksack/travel bag (in case of spills).
